The Hunters for the Hungry program has made remarkable progress in this past year, thanks to the new legislation passed in the recent session of the Louisiana legislature. Additional protection has been guaranteed to those serving donated game to food banks and other support organizations. Starting in the summer of 2014, we will also be the recipient of the voluntary contributions resulting from requests made in the issuance of Louisiana hunting and fishing licenses.

We appreciate your help and support in feeding people in our communities through your time and talent.

Because we have been recently advised of additional precautions that should be followed in processing hogs, we will **not** be accepting wild **hogs** through our Hunters for the Hungry processor program effective immediately. As our program continues to grow with your help, and the help of our community, we hope to revisit our ability to accept wild hog donations later down the road.

We are pleased to attach a memo from Louisiana Wildlife & Fisheries that addresses precautions that should be followed in order to reduce the risk of contracting any disease by people handling or dressing feral hogs.

Once again, our sincere thanks for your support and we look forward to working with you in processing deer for Hunters for the Hungry in our upcoming hunting season.
